Darmasiswa is a scholarship offered to all foreigners from countries which have diplomatic relationship with Indonesia to study Indonesian language, culture, music, dance, and art. This program is organized by the Indonesian Ministry of Education and Culture (MoEC) in cooperation with the Indonesian Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MoFA)

Every year there are more than 860 scholarships provided. The Darmasiswa program is essentially a "non-degree" program which has two different types based on the length of stay in Indonesia:

• 6 months (September - February)

• 12 months (September - July/August)
